Traditional protocols for diagnosing autism have been criticized for focusing too heavily on deficits and problems and failing to generalize across populations. This workshop provides <u>innovative strategies</u> for enabling providers to <u>assess for strengths associated with autism</u> across the lifespan. In addition, an effective, meaningful method for communicating both strengths and challenges at the feedback session is showcased. Teleassessment strategies are becoming increasingly important in light of the global pandemic and this workshop will equip providers with tools that can be used effectively for remote assessments.
