

Practicing Culturally Responsive ABA: A Tool for Self and Client Assessment

Successful ABA intervention hinges on a clinician's ability to acknowledge when your own values and beliefs may be impacting your practice. Behavior analysts should identify their own cultural identities and engage clients in important conversations designed to understand client priorities based on culture, customs, values, and beliefs with the goal of creating more compassionate and inclusive treatment intervention plans. In this workshop, you will learn why cultural humility and responsivity is important, review research and practice recommendations, and be introduced to a tool to utilize to assess both your own and your clients' customs, beliefs, and values.
