DRIVING DIRECTIONS

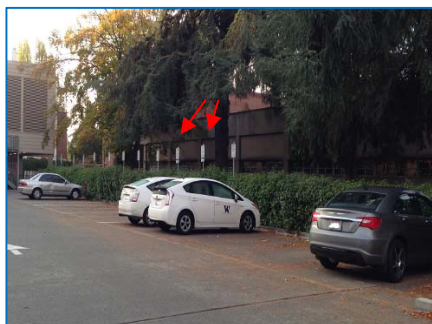
From Interstate 5: Take the N.E. 45th Street Exit (Exit # 169), located north of downtown Seattle. Head east at the end of the exit ramp onto NE 45th Street for half a mile and turn right onto 15th Avenue NE. Take 15th Avenue all the way down to the water (stay in the right lane to avoid turning left onto NE Pacific Street). Once you cross NE Pacific Street, 15th Avenue curves to the left, and brings you to the S1 parking lot gatehouse. The IHDD is located at the far end of the S1 lot.

From Route 520: Take the Montlake Boulevard Exit and head north across the Montlake bridge. Just after you cross the bridge, turn left onto NE Pacific Street and drive past the UW Medical Center (on your left). Turn left onto 15th Avenue NE and continue as it curves left, until you get to the S1 parking lot gatehouse. The IHDD is located at the far end of the S1 lot.

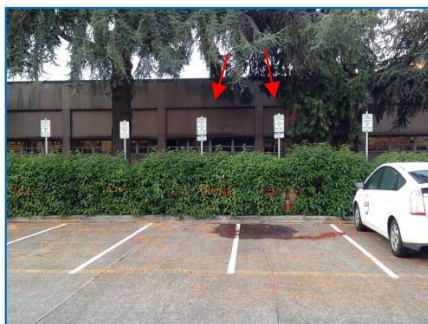
PARKING

Parking Option 1: UWAC Pre-Paid Parking Spaces

- We have **2 parking spaces on S-2, the middle level of the parking deck near the entrance to the Portage Bay clinic** dedicated for the use of our clients, research participants and visitors. These 2 parking spaces are pre-paid so you do not need to stop at the gatehouse or pay to use them. Please only use these 2 pre-paid parking spaces if you have not already paid for parking.
- To utilize these spots, contact your patient navigator, research scheduler, your clinician or person you are visiting to get hang tag(s) for your upcoming visit(s). If you arrive and park in one of our dedicated spots and do not have a hang tag, let the person you are seeing know and we will give you a tag to take out to your car.
- Please note: the spots are first-come, first-served, so if you drive by and they are in use, you will need to drive to the gatehouse to get a paid parking pass for the S-2 middle level (instructions can be found below).

Parking Option 2: Kiosk hourly paid parking on the S-1 (top level)

- There is limited hourly paid parking spots on the top level of the parking structure. If spots are available on this level, you can use pay-by-phone or the kiosk in the lot to pay for the length of time you need.

Parking Option 3: Paid Parking Pass from the Gate House for the S-2 (middle-level)

- Go to the Gate House on NE Columbia Road and request a parking permit for the S-2 level. Let the Gate House know that you are there for an Autism Center appointment. Passes for this level are limited to the all-day rate. The Gate House is staffed from 6am-9pm Monday through Friday. If for some reason the Gate House is not staffed you can contact parking at 206-685-1553.
- You will receive a parking permit and a QR code with instructions.
- Proceed to the S-2 parking (middle level of the deck) and park and place the parking permit on your dashboard
- In the event that the middle level is full, you can proceed to the lower level, S-3 and use the QR code to raise the arm. You will need to use the QR code to get in and out of this level.



FINDING THE IHDD

The IHDD is a 4-story brick building just **east of the S1** parking lot. There are two entrances. Please do not park in front of the Ground Floor Entrance. Please pull into the loading lane in front of the Main Entrance. The main entrance facing the UW Medical Center leads you up a ramp and directly into the reception area.
