This seminar will describe a multi-level, evidence-based parenting intervention, the Triple P Positive Parenting Program (Triple P). The Triple P program is designed as a public health strategy to prevent and address emotional and behavioral problems in children through improving parenting skills and confidence. This seminar will describe the different levels of program intensity, briefly describe the research base, and discuss how the program has been used within diverse service settings (with a particular emphasis on potential implications for child welfare).

Suzanne Kerns, PhD., is an Assistant Professor at the University of Washington Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences, Division of Public Behavioral Health and Justice Policy. Clinical and research interests focus on translation of evidence based practices to real-world settings, their acquisition, adoption, and sustainability. She currently collaborates with agencies, communities and Tribes to develop strategic planning to increase effective utilization of evidence-based practices. Dr. Kerns has been a certified trainer, practitioner, and consultant for the Triple P Parenting Program for over 10 years.
