Potential Placement Resources/Contacts -- Explanation of Measures

Date Identified -- date this individual was identified by the project social worker from client records, interview respondents, or others. This date can **not** be earlier than the referral date.

Type -- type of individual who may act as placement resource, support, or potential adoptive parent.

Contact Level -- frequency of contact between individual and case

Types of Support

Concrete -- provides real, tangible, physical assistance. For example, providing a ride when needed, help with moving things, assistance with money matters, etc.

Emotional -- provides help with how client is feeling. For example, provide comfort when upset, listens to client talk about how they feel.

Informational -- provides information concerning tasks or decisions. For example, helps with homework, strategizes with client to solve a personal problem, lends client a bus schedule, etc.

Support (response categories)

Contact Strength--worker judgment of the strength of the resource connection with the client.
