## Sexual Assault Services

### ***CORE Sexual Assault Services:***

CORE sexual assault services are provided at no fee to victims of sexual assault and their non-offending family members.

#### **Information and referral and awareness**

Response to requests from victims, families and service providers for information or assistance related to sexual abuse and assault.

#### **Crisis Intervention**

Responding and assisting by phone or in person to people in sexual assault – related crisis.

#### **Legal and medical advocacy**

Helping and supporting victims to ensure their interests are represented and rights upheld in the legal and medical systems.

#### **General advocacy**

Providing support and assistance in accessing specialized sexual assault services.

#### **System Coordination**

Coordinating with community service providers to ensure victim's needs are met.

#### **Prevention Services**

Working with the community to build skills and develop strategies to prevent sexual assault.

## ***Evaluation and Treatment***

### **Medical examinations**

- Emergency care after sexual assault for evidence collection and medical care
- Follow up medical care for victims who were seen in the emergency department
- Scheduled evaluations for children and teens where there is a concern for sexual abuse

### **Psychosocial evaluations**

To assess impact of sexual abuse; and in some cases to make recommendations when there is suspicion of sexual abuse.

### **Therapy**

Evidence based counseling to assist victims and families to recover from the trauma of sexual assault. Specific intervention models include:

- Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for children, adolescents and their families
- Cognitive Processing Therapy for adults
- Prolonged Exposure Therapy for adults

### **Evaluation and treatment of child sexual behavior problems**

For young children who are sexually acting out.

*Initial counseling appointment is free. Fees for counseling are on a sliding fee scale. Crime Victims Compensation, Medicaid and other insurance may apply.*



### ***To request services***

All services are provided by experienced professional staff including social workers, physicians, nurse practitioners, and nurses.

Services can be accessed 24 hours a day by calling the Harborview Abuse and Trauma Center. Please ask for the Emergency Department social worker on nights and weekends.
