Most sexual assault survivors turn to loved ones—such as friends, family, partners—for support after sexual assault. Although these loved ones often want to help, they frequently respond to survivors in unhelpful ways. The presenters will describe the CARE Program, which is a new option to improve the support offered by loved ones of recent survivors.
