


















Damaged oxygen cylinders from the passenger compartment

Oxygen Cylinders

- 7 relatively empty cylinders retrieved from luggage bay
 - Little fire damage
- 11 cylinders retrieved from passenger compartment
 - Extensive damage and all released oxygen
- The pressure relief values actuate at 260 degrees F





Wilmer, Texas, Motorcoach Fire

- Evacuation from Hurricane Rita
 - September 23, 2005
 - 1998 MCI motorcoach
 - Wheel fire
 - -23 elderly passenger fatalities



- Charles Town, West Virginia
 - -July 15, 2003
 - 1989 MCI motorcoach
 - Brake fire
 - 3 senior citizens injured, 2 while exiting windows







- Meriden, Connecticut
 - August 16, 2005
 - 2002 Van Hool motorcoach with 45 passengers
 - Right rear wheel fire
 - Non-English-speaking driver
 - No injuries





- Bass River, New Jersey
 - October 23, 2005
 - 1998 Dina Motorcoach with 40 passengers
 - Left rear tag axle tire fire
 - No injuries





- Banning, California
 - December 6, 2005
 - 2001 Van Hool motorcoach with 61 passengers
 - Fire in rear of vehicle
 - No injuries





- Lampasas, Texas
 - -October 4, 2005
 - School bus
 - Engine fire
 - Ninth grade volleyball team
 - No injuries





- Wilsonville, Oregon
 - -May 13, 2006
 - 1998 Prevost motorcoach transporting a high school band
 - Right rear tag axle tire fire
 - No injuries
