WrapStat is Live!

WERT is excited to announce that WrapStat launched September 1st. We are working to get users into the system and creating new ways to train folks. Given the complexity of the system, we have developed a series of short videos, FAQs, and templates in addition to our User Manual to help users navigate the system.

WrapStat Feature: Evaluation Cycles

This month, we would like to highlight our Evaluation Cycle feature. The evaluation cycle is designed to help Wraparound initiatives pull a more representative sample when administering one of the WFAS tools. When creating an evaluation cycle, users will establish a timeframe for data collection, select which sites to administer the tool to, and establish the sampling criteria. Based on this information, WrapStat will randomly pull a sample from the youth roster. Programs will then work to administer the tool for all youth in the sample. This feature allows for a more rigorous sampling methodology and helps Wraparound initiatives avoid common errors - such as convenience sampling - when administering the fidelity tools.
